

10 things to do today

- 1 Enjoy the 2 mile circular lakeside walk by the River Trent and through the woods.
- 2 Lose yourself and shout for help in the Hide and Speak Maze and enjoy the Adventure Playground.
- 3 Get naked from the knees down and brave the Barefoot Walk.
- 4 Take a walk up Monument Hill to appreciate spectacular views of Trentham and beyond.
- 5 Meander through the gardens; take in the scents and seasonally changing vistas.
- 6 Look out for classical and contemporary sculpture in the gardens.
- 7 Climb onto the viewing platform in the Upper Flower Garden for the best view of the Italian Garden.
- 8 Spot the herons; at last count there were 42 breeding pairs nesting on the islands.
- 9 See the remains of Trentham Hall in this quiet corner of the garden - there's a love seat here too!
- 10 ...or simply sit back, relax and enjoy the scenery.

Frequently Asked Questions

How can we take a boat or train ride?

The boat, miniature train and rowing boats operate seasonally and extra charges apply. The catamaran is about a 20 minute, one way trip. Pick up a timetable or buy tickets on the boat, or at the main entrance. Rowing boats are available to hire by the hour; please pay the attendant in cash. Train tickets are for a return journey; please make a cash payment to the guard.

Where can we eat?

The Italian Garden Tearoom and Lakeside Cafe offer a delicious menu. We welcome picnicking and tables are available by the lakeside and around the gardens.

Is our dog welcome?

We welcome dogs on short leads. Please use the dog refuse bins and avoid the playground, maze and barefoot walk. Dogs are not allowed in the Monkey Forest.

I'm a visitor with limited mobility, how can you help?

Most areas of the gardens are accessible to wheelchair users. Inaccessible areas are clearly marked as unsuitable. Manual wheelchairs are available on a first come, first served basis from the main entrance. A deposit is required. There are lots of benches around the lake and gardens. Find disabled toilets at the main entrance, the Tearoom and in the Shopping Village.

Can we re-enter the gardens?

Yes, please retain your ticket and show it to re-enter as many times as you like the same day.

Can we cycle?

Sorry, only under 5s can cycle, at walking pace.
